Students will slowly transition to attending school 5 days in the building.

Elementary students will not have to wear masks in the core group while in the classroom.

Secondary students will need to wear masks even in the academic setting.

Hand sanitizer will be readily available at entrances and in every classroom.

Cleaning and disinfecting will occur multiple times throughout the day.

Building administrator will determine the length of visitor's time in a school based on the nature of the visit.

If children live at the same address but have different last names, the school will determine which days students will attend.

One time transfer between attending school in the building and virtual learning after two weeks.

Mason County Teacher Led - Classes online led by Mason County teachers. Classes will be comparable in content to that which is held in the building. Assignments will differ slightly from in person teaching, but the same learning standards will apply.

WVDE Virtual School – Offered by WVDE. Students enrolled earn credits toward graduation at the secondary level and are still enrolled in Mason County Schools. Students are responsible for their own progress when enrolled.
